




Recommendation Supported by Health Department:



- WCPS should return to fully virtual instruction beginning tomorrow (Wednesday) for all students Prek-12
- The target date for resuming hybrid learning will be January 4, 2021 for grades Prek-8
- The target date for high school return will remain at February 2, 2021
- We will consider returning to hybrid learning when the metrics show
 - 7 consecutive days of Positivity Rate below 5% AND
 - 7 consecutive days of New Case Rate below 15 per 100,000
- Teachers may teach from classrooms or other locations with administrator confirmation
- Meals will continue to be served
- Sports and other extracurricular activities are on hold for now
- Special Education assessments will continue on a case-by-case basis
